- (1) Includes shares awarded under a Restricted Stock Plan. Restricted shares vest as follows: 75,000 on 11/1/2009, 60,000 shares on 1/3/2010, 7,500 shares on 8/1/2011 and 75,000 shares on 11/1/2011.  
The number of underlying securities is based on the stock fund balance on January 3, 2008. The actual number of shares issuable upon the
  - (2) distribution date is not determinable since the stock fund is a unitized account consisting of 96% company stock and 4% money market fund. The stock account balance reflected in this report is based on a January 3, 2008, stock fund price of \$35.02 per share.  
Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. Shares of phantom stock are
  - (3) payable in cash following the reporting person's termination of employment with the company and may be transferred by the reporting person into an alternative investment account at any time.
  - (4) Includes 194.41 phantom stock units acquired through reinvestment of dividends on January 3, 2008, at a price of 35.02 per phantom unit.
  - (5) The phantom stock units were accrued under the Johnson Controls Equalization 401(k) Benefit Plan and are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's retirement.  
Each share of phantom stock is the economic equivalent of one share of Johnson Controls common stock. The phantom stock units were
  - (6) accrued under the Johnson Controls Deferred Restricted Stock Plan. Phantom units related to a deferred restricted stock grant are to be settled 100% in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment with the company, pending vesting. Phantom units related to non-deferred restricted stock grants are to be settled 100% in cash upon vesting of the related grant.
  - (7) Includes 1595.392 phantom stock units acquired through reinvestment of dividends on January 3, 2008, at a price of 35.02 per phantom unit.
  - (8) Fifty percent of the options vest after two years and the remaining 50% vests after three years.
