(including, without limitation, concepts of  
good faith, fair dealing and the lack of bad  
faith), provided that such counsel  
expresses no opinion as to the effect of  
fraudulent conveyance, fraudulent transfer  
or similar provision of applicable law on  
the conclusions expressed above. This  
opinion is given as of the date hereof and  
is limited to the laws of the State of New  
York and the General Corporation Law of

the State of Delaware as in effect on the date hereof.
